I would like to take the opportunity to welcome back all of our returning Virginia Parks Panther's and their families, as well as those of you who are new to us this year! There are many exciting things in store for the students at Virginia Parks as well as the students in the CUSD. I would like to take a moment to thank all of our families, community, staff and our PTC for staying focused on the main thing "instruction" and ensuring high levels of learning for ALL students. As we have transitioned into the common core, I commend our staff and teachers for working hard to provide our students with high expectations and a standards-based education.

As many of you are aware. Ceres Unified School District is a 1:World district. As we enter into the 2018-19 school year, ALL students will continue to have a technology device checked out to them. This chromebook will be assigned to this student for the next few years. This has also equalized the playing field for students in preparation for career and college.
